BCGBA Management Committee Representative report

This report refers to the meeting held on Saturday 20th February 2010.

The BCGBA club championship will be at Centre Vale Park in Todmorden again in October.

The Officers Working Group had come up with a set of proposals to decide the outcome of a county man of the match.

The coaching DVD to level 3 will be produced. The Coaching Administrator said that a priority for the year is to ease the progression of coaches through the levels.

The Welfare Officer confirmed proposed that in order to comply with the law, no county should take part in the Junior County Championship if their Junior officials do not have CRB clearance. This was confirmed by the meeting and will be discussed at the Secretaries meeting.

A sub-committee of the development group containing many of the top players, administrators and press met and proposed that the BCGBA should seek a patron, one member of the group to attend BCGBA meeting as an observer and that Dave West should become the new BCGBA photographer. They will have further meetings throughout the year.

The storage for BCGBA documents has been purchased and a number of proposals for an increase in BCGBA revenue were circulated to the members for consideration which will be voted on in June. Most of the proposals will, of course, not affect this year finances. They include an increase in the BCGBA membership, Club fee and open competition fee. Also circulated was the proposal to increase the prize money for the BCGBA County Championship.

Minutes of the Alliance meetings will be circulated at the BCGBA meeting.
